Section IV GENERAL PERSONNEL INTERIM PROCEDURES

1. Working Hours

- 1.1 All full-time City employees have a regular work week of forty (40) hours.
- 1.2 The normal work day begins at 8:00 a.m. and ends at 5:00 p.m. with a one-hour lunch break between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. The exception being that designated office attendant for lunch hour will take lunch break between hours of 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m.
- 1.3 In consideration of shift requirements, seasonal conditions, special service needs, and other activities necessary to provide a continuity of public service, it is frequently necessary to deviate from the normal work day. In any of the above cases, it is the responsibility of the department head to prescribe working hours and to authorize compensatory time for any hours worked in excess of eight (8) hours.
- 1.4 All permanent part-time employees requiring fewer than forty (40) hours per week will have their schedule determined for each month and that schedule posted on bulletin board prior to the 1st of each month.
- 1.5 All temporary part-time employees requiring fewer than forty (40) hours per week will have their schedule determined for each month and that schedule posted on bulletin board prior to the 1st of each month.

2. Attendance

- 2.1 Employees are expected to be at their work stations in accordance with the established working hours.
- 2.2 Employees who are to be absent from duty for any reasons shall notify their immediate supervisor or department head, stating the reasons for the absence, not later than thirty (30) minutes prior to their scheduled time for beginning work.

- 2.3 Except in emergency situations, employees who become ill, suffer an injury, or who have another reason for leaving their work units during working hours shall notify their immediate supervisor or department head before leaving.
- 2.4 Employees who are absent from duty due to illness or injury may be required, at the discretion of the department head, to present a doctor's statement on the nature of the illness or injury. All employees who are absent for more than three (3) consecutive working days shall be required to present a doctor's statement before returning to work, unless released from this requirement by department head.
- 2.5 The supervisors or department head of each work unit shall submit daily an employee "Report of Absence" to the Personnel Office to be entered upon Monthly Activity Report each day.
