The Council will hear public comments related to both agenda and non-agenda items. Only citizens who have signed the applicable signin sheet and who reside in the city limits will be permitted to address the council, and each person will be allowed to address the Council only once. Each citizen in the city limits is allowed to speak for three (3) minutes. Complaints or charges against an officer or employee of the city should be reserved for a closed meeting under section 551.074 of the Texas Government Code. Failure to adhere to these policies may result in removal from the meeting. Members of the city council are prohibited from entering into deliberation. Under the laws of the State of Texas, the Council is not permitted to discuss non-agenda items. The Council is only permitted to recite statements of fact and city policies; no discussion is permitted.
