ORDINANCE NO. O-11042019-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ELKHART, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING A DATE AND TIME FOR REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- WHEREAS, the City of Elkhart, Texas is a Type A General Law municipality organized and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of Texas;
- WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Exhart. Texas, has discretion to set the regular meetings of its City Council on a date and time which best serves the City Council members. City staff and the citizens of the City of Elkhart; and
- WHEREAS, by the passing of this Ordinance, the City Council hereby sets a date and time for its regular City Council meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELKHART, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1: FINDINGS OF FACT

The findings set forth above are incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein. Further findings that the Regular City Council meetings of the City of Elkhart, Texas shall be held on the first Monday of each month, beginning at 6:00 p.m., with a reservation clause that all Council members must be available on the third Monday of each month, in the event a second meeting is required.

Section 2: SEVERABILITY

In the event any section, sub-section, clause, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance shall be declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall in no means affect any other section, sub-section, clause sentence, or phrase of this ordinance, but all the rest thereof shall be in full force and effect just as though the section, sub-section, sentence, clause or phrase so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part thereof.

Section 3: REPEALER

This Ordinance repeals any and all prior Ordinances, resolutions or mandates of the Elkhart City Council which may be in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4: EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
